Recognition of indications on medication pack

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1. When receiving medication pack, pharmacist shall advise patient the correct usage of medication.
In any events, relevant indications should be printed on medication pack. For ease of reference, some hospitals may provide patient with diagrams of medication time frame on medication pack.
2. According to the Department of Health, the medication packs should contain 13 essential labels and 3 recommendation labels.

13 labeled descriptions are as follows:

1. Patient's name
2. Patient's gender
3. Drug's name
4. Drug's dosage
5. Drug's quantity
6. Usage
7. Dosage
8. Name of pharmacy
9. Pharmacy's address
10. Telephone number of the dispensing pharmacy
11. Name of dispenser
12. Date of dispensing
13. Warning notes

Three recommendation labels:

1. Main adaptive illness
2. Main side effects
3. Other medication instructions

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
